Victor's Bocce House Rules

ALL alcoholic beverages must be purchased at Victor's. No Exceptions!!!

The court closes at 10:00PM in consideration of our neighbors.

The **Winning** team will submit the scores electronically.



The Losing team MUST sweep the court after games and after practice. A broom is located in Bocce Shed. To properly reset the court, fix divots with a shuffle of a shoe and then drag the broom **upside down**, using the bristles only, not the wooden head.

BOCCE RULES

- 1. Only one player on the court at a time during play.
- 2. NO coaching from the side lines. Players may coach his/her partner.
- 3. Coin toss winner rolls first and picks ball color.
- 4. Both feet must be inside the court when rolling.
- 5. Player rolls ball exact distance from jack as opponent. Last person to roll, rolls again.
- 6. If player rolls wrong color ball, replace it with his/her ball.
- 7. Jack ball out of court? Restart frame.
- 8. If jack ball doesn't land in play area (between red and white sights) on initial roll then player gets one additional try before opponent gets to roll. If opponent misses twice, original player places ball anywhere in play area.
- 9. If ball hits the back wall of court without touching another ball, the ball is removed from play.
- 10. If both players' closest balls are equidistant to the jack ball at the end of the frame, no score is tallied and play continues at the other end of the court.
- 11. Season matches will go to 12 points. You don't have to win by 2 points. The winner is first to 12 at the end of the frame.
- 12. Play off matches will go to 11 points. You must win by 2 points.
- 13. Championship matches will go to 13 points. You must win by 2 points.
- 14. Winning team submits score via QR code link in binder.
- 15. Losing team sweeps the court with broom upside down.
- 16. Only two (2) subs allowed during regular season play. Subs may NOT be current players in our league. NO subs are allowed for the playoffs and championship. *Exception* Player is unable to finish the season due to physical disability and you have a permanent sub.
- 17. Players that do not finish the season are not eligible to play next season.
- 18. Forfeit determined when match is scheduled and opponents are more then 10 minutes late without a phone call.
- 19. Unplayed matches receive zero (0) points, with the exception of a forfeit.
- 20. The Bocce Committee will settle any and all questionable matters.
